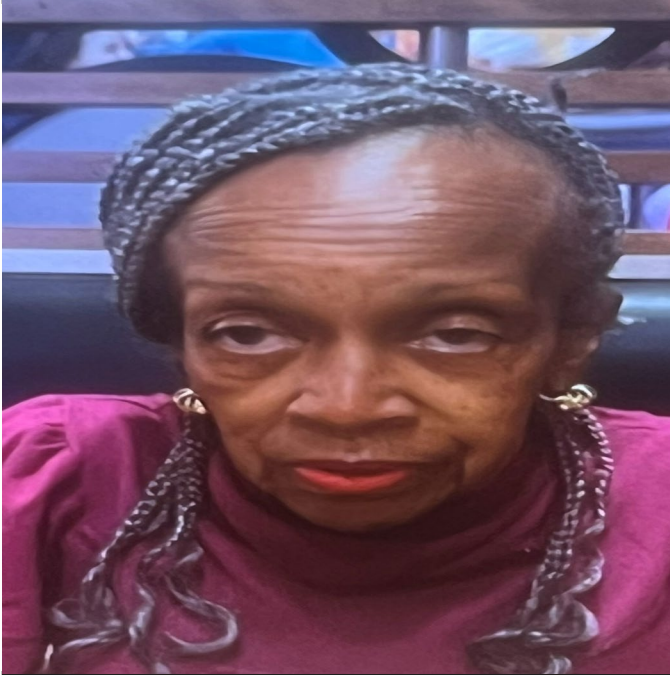

## DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT
